

**TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN**

**ORDINANCE NO. 1-2010**

**AMENDING CHAPTER 6-31D OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN ENTITLED “ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE”**

WHEREAS, there is created in the Code of the Township of Moorestown, under Chapter 6, Section 31D, an Economic Development Advisory Committee (“EDAC”); and

WHEREAS, the EDAC, pursuant to the Code, consists of nine members; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Code, it is the duty of the EDAC to promote the advantages of the Township of Moorestown for business, commercial and industrial users and to encourage expansion of existing industry and business in the best interest of the Township; and

WHEREAS, there exists a Moorestown Business Association (“MBA”) in the Township of Moorestown which serves a liaison between the business community and the local government and which also encourages the creation and expansion of local businesses while maintaining Moorestown’s historical integrity; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council believes that official input and participation by the MBA on the EDAC will be beneficial to the EDAC and the Township as a whole; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council wishes to amend the membership to include the President of the Moorestown Business Association as a member of the EDAC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council, of the Township of Moorestown, in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that:

Section 1: Chapter 6-31D “Economic Development Advisory Committee” of the Code of the Township of Moorestown, shall be amended as follows.

Paragraph D.(1)(a) shall be amended as follows:

- (a) The Economic Development Advisory Committee shall consist of nine members, one of whom shall be a member of the Township Council, ~~and~~ one of whom shall be a member of the Planning Board, and one of whom shall be the President of the Moorestown Business Association. The Township Council and the Planning Board shall each respectively, at its annual reorganization meeting, appoint one of its members to the Economic Development Advisory Committee. The Planning Board member shall be appointed from the Class IV members of the Board. The Township Council, at its annual reorganization meeting,

shall appoint the “President of the Moorestown Business Association” to the Economic Development Advisory Committee and the President of the Moorestown Business Association shall take its seat on the Economic Development Advisory Committee after the annual reorganization meeting of the Moorestown Business Association in January each year.

Section 2: Paragraph (c) shall be deleted in its entirety and the following language inserted in its place:

- (c) The Township Council, the Township Planning Board and the Moorestown Business Association members shall each be appointed in January for periods of one year.

The term of any member of the Township Council, the Planning Board or President of the Moorestown Business Association who has been appointed to the Committee shall be automatically deemed vacant in the event that such member is no longer a member of the Township Council, Planning Board or President of the Moorestown Business Association. Their replacements shall be named by the Township Council, the Planning Board and the Moorestown Business Association, respectively to fulfill the unexpired term.

The remaining six members shall be appointed for a two-year term by the Township Council. A vacancy occurring, other than by expiration of the term, shall be filled for the unexpired term only.

Section 3: All other sections of Chapter 6-31D shall remain unchanged.

Section 4: Repealer. Any and all other ordinances inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 5: Severability. In the event that any section paragraph, clause phrase, term, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, such judgment shall not effect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the section, paragraph, clause, term, provision or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in such judgment shall be rendered.

Section 6:     Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon proper publication and in accordance with law.

Section 7:     Short Title.     This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance 1-2010.
