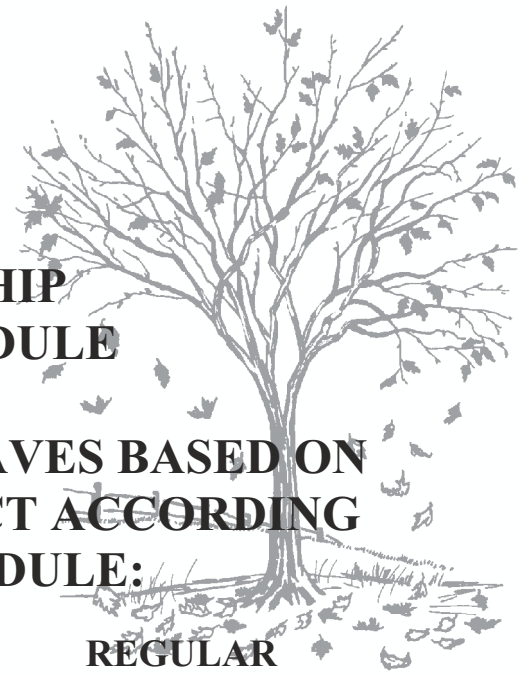




**SPRING 2010
MOORESTOWN TOWNSHIP
LEAF COLLECTION SCHEDULE**



**THE TOWNSHIP WILL COLLECT LEAVES BASED ON
YOUR TRASH COLLECTION DISTRICT ACCORDING
TO THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULE:**

DATE OF PICKUP	DISTRICT	REGULAR TRASH COLLECTION DAY
APRIL 5-9	1	MONDAY
APRIL 12-16	2	TUESDAY
APRIL 19-23	3	WEDNESDAY
APRIL 26-30	4	THURSDAY

Leaves must be raked to the area between the curb and sidewalk by 7 AM on Monday of your scheduled collection week. As per Ordinance #1544-90, leaves are not to be placed in the street or traveled way and pursuant to State Stormwater Management Regulations, leaves may not be placed within ten (10) feet of storm drain inlets.

Bagged leaves or leaves placed in waste receptacles will not be collected with your normal trash. All leaves must be separated from household trash. Bagged leaves will be burst open for pick-up during the scheduled leaf pick-up program. Brush must not be mixed with leaves.

Residents may bring their leaves to the Compost Center on Creek Road every other Saturday, from 12:00-4:00 PM. (See reverse side of notice for Compost Center Schedule)

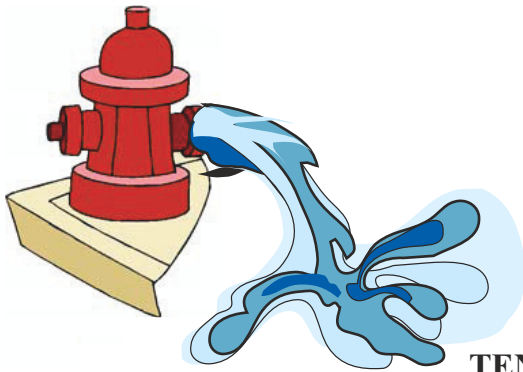
If leaves are not collected in your area during the designated week, they will be picked up as soon as possible thereafter. Wet weather often delays removal.



CREEK ROAD COMPOST FACILITY

The Township Compost Facility on Creek Road (Between Borton Landing and Centerton Road) is open to Moorestown Residents on designated Saturdays only (see chart below) from 12:00 Noon to 4:00 pm, for the disposal of leaves and brush. No grass, dirt, soil, mulch, wood chips or other yard debris accepted. ***Debris from clearing operations will not be accepted. These are the contractor/s and or property owner's responsibility for proper disposal. Contractor/s Commercial vehicle/s not permitted.
