RESOLUTION NO. 212-2014

AWARDING A CONTRACT TO CIVIC PLUS FOR WEBSITE REDESIGN AND IMPLEMENTATION OF A WEB CONTENT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the Township Council has tasked the Telecommunications and Technology Committee and Township staff with reviewing and recommending improvements to the Township's website; and

WHEREAS, the Telecommunications and Technology Committee and Township staff have viewed various websites, reviewed the township's website requirements and met with and evaluated various vendors; and

WHEREAS, CIVICPLUS of Manhattan, Kansas has provided a proposal to redesign the website and implement a web content management system; and

WHEREAS, the Telecommunications and Technology Committee and Township staff, after an in-depth review and evaluation process are recommending CIVICPLUS as the best vendor to meet the Township's needs and requirements in providing a state of the art website for the benefit of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to approve and enter into the contract, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-12 et seq., and under GSA contract #GS-35F-0124U with CIVICPLUS for the redesign of the Township's website and the implementation of a web content management system in the amount of \$23,749.52; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Finance Officer has filed the required Certification of Funds with the Township Clerk.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that a contract in the amount of \$23,749.52 be awarded to CIVICPLUS under GSA Contract No. GS-35F-0124U for the redesign of the Township's website and implementation of a web content management system as set forth in the contract attached hereto, and subject to issuance of the appropriate purchase order to CIVICPLUS, 317 Houston Street, Suite E, Manhattan, Kansas 66502.
