**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN
AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN
APPLICATION TO SUSTAINABLE JERSEY TO RECEIVE
GRANT FUNDING FOR GENERAL FUNDING OF ACTIVITIES
BY SUSTAINABLE MOORESTOWN**

WHEREAS, Sustainable Jersey, in conjunction with PSEG, has created the Sustainable Jersey Small Grants Program to provide resources to municipalities for the purpose of supporting sustainability efforts in New Jersey communities; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Moorestown has established Sustainable Moorestown, a Green Team pursuant to Sustainable Jersey criteria, which received Bronze Certification in 2013 and Silver Certification in 2014, for the purpose of pursuing sustainability as a means to optimize the quality of life for its residents; and

WHEREAS, Sustainable Moorestown has identified activities which qualify for a \$2,000 Capacity Building Grant to support the general activities of Sustainable Moorestown for the period of April, 2015 through March, 2016, which activities will include but may not be limited to the promotion of local business, the education of the community on sustainable practices and specific energy reduction/conservation programs to benefit municipality buildings; or alternatively, a grant to fund Capacity Building activities as well as a Green Fair of either \$10,000 or \$20,000; and

WHEREAS, one of the purposes of the Sustainable Jersey Program is to provide resources to municipalities to make progress on sustainability issues; and

WHEREAS, in order to secure formal approval for the grant funding, the Township is required to submit an application which will authorize the Township to be the entity to receive the grant funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown as follows:

1. Sustainable Moorestown is hereby authorized to prepare and submit a grant application to the Sustainable Jersey Small Grants and Grant Program and undertake all other necessary actions to secure the funding.
