

**TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN**

**RESOLUTION NO. 72-2015**

**AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN  
APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDING TO PROVIDE  
EDUCATIONAL SIGNAGE AT STRAWBRIDGE LAKE PARK**

WHEREAS, grant monies have been made available by the Association of New Jersey Environmental Commissions (ANJEC) to fund projects that maintain and educate citizens concerning use of local open space, and raise the profile of Moorestown's Environmental Advisory Committee (MEAC) through publicity and public participation and local collaboration with local environmental groups in the community; and

WHEREAS, Strawbridge Lake Park is an important natural resource to Moorestown Township providing recreational opportunities such as walking, biking, picnicking and fishing for Township residents, as well as, Burlington and Camden County residents; and

WHEREAS, ANJEC is offering \$1500 in funding to municipal environmental commissions created by ordinance to perform projects related to preservation, management, maintenance, restoration or education concerning open space; and

WHEREAS, a local non-profit organization, STEM, has volunteered to assist MEAC with implementation of an educational project including signage at Strawbridge Lake Park should ANJEC award the \$1500 grant to MEAC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, that MEAC is authorized to prepare and submit an application for grant funding on behalf of the Township of Moorestown to pay for the cost of educational signage at Strawbridge Lake Park, with the understanding that this authorization does not obligate the Township to spend any Township funds in connection with the application, nor is the Township committing to designate any such funds in the future.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor of the Township of Moorestown is hereby authorized to execute the application for grant funding which complies with the findings set forth herein.
