

TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN

RESOLUTION NO. 97-2015

AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN TO ENTER INTO AND EXECUTE A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE BURLINGTON COUNTY BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDER FOR EMERGENCY PAVEMENT REPAIR

WHEREAS, the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 *et seq.*, authorizes and empowers municipalities to enter into shared services agreements; and

WHEREAS, the Burlington County Board of Chosen Freeholders requested R.D. Zeuli Inc. to provide a price based on the fact that other entities (i.e. Boroughs, Townships or other quasi-governmental entities) would be able to utilize the successful bidder's services for this work; and

WHEREAS, the Burlington County Board of Chosen Freeholders has authorized, by resolution, an emergency paving contract entitled Emergency Asphalt Paving Services for Burlington County (CEG-15-0024) with R.D. Zeuli Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the Burlington County Board of Chosen Freeholders deems it appropriate to memorialize the specific terms and conditions of the services in a shared services agreement between the County and the various municipalities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that the Mayor and Clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute a Shared Services Agreement with the County of Burlington for emergency asphalt paving services, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:65-5, which is incorporated herein by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said agreement shall be placed on file in the office of the Township Clerk for public inspection.
