RESOLUTION TO RE-AUTHORIZE SUSTAINABLE MOORESTOWN

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown believes it is important to save our citizens tax dollars, assure clean air and water, strive to improve working and living environments within our community, support our local economy and create opportunities for economic, social and environmental sustainability which will help Moorestown to thrive; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown wishes to generate activities and programs which will benefit our residents now and in the future with sustainable community initiatives which are easy to replicate and affordable to implement; and

WHEREAS, in an attempt to focus attention on Sustainable issues, the Township Council in Resolution No. 122-2012 dated July 9, 2012 authorized the creation of the Green Team Advisory Committee, known as “Sustainable Moorestown,” as a sub-committee of the Township’s Environmental Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, since its creation in 2012, Sustainable Moorestown has secured grant money, oversaw the Township’s Bronze and Silver certification through Sustainable Jersey, conducted a number of sustainable events and has otherwise promoted the idea of sustainability throughout the Township; and

WHEREAS, for the above reasons, the Township Council desires that Sustainable Moorestown should continue such efforts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, that Sustainable Moorestown is hereby re-authorized for the purpose of continuing its efforts to organize and oversee the Township’s sustainability efforts, including the Township’s Sustainable Jersey certification process and submittals.
