ORDINANCE NO. 28-2015

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN AMENDING
CHAPTER 56 (CONSTRUCTION CODES, UNIFORM), ARTICLE I (UNIFORM
CONSTRUCTION CODES), SECTION 56-3 ENTITLED FEES; REPORTS**

WHEREAS, the Township of Moorestown wishes to adopt a Municipal Uniform Construction Code Fee Schedule.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 56, Article I, Section 56-3 be amended as follows:

Section 1: Chapter 56, Article I, Section 56-3 be amended as follows:

A. The fees to be charged by the Construction Code Official shall be set annually by resolution of the governing body.

~~A.~~ B. In the event the township requires the services of a third-party inspection agency, the fees to be charged by the Construction Code Official and each third-party inspection agency employed by the township shall hereafter be as set forth in the fee schedule contained in the administrative code provisions enacted by the State of New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, N.J.A.C. 5:23-4.17 through 5:23-4.20 and N.J.A.C. 5:23-8.10 and as amended by contracts in effect at the time. The fees set forth herein shall automatically be revised or amended without further action by the Township Council upon the promulgation of amendments or revision to N.J.A.C. 5-23-4.17 through N.J.A.C. 5:23-4.20 and N.J.A.C. 5:23-8.10 and by the State of New Jersey Department of Community Affairs or its successor agency.

Section 2: The subsequent paragraphs in Section 56-3 shall be re-lettered C through H.

Section 3: Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause, phrase, term, provision or part of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or inoperative, such judgment shall not affect, inhere or invalidate the remainder thereof, which shall be confined in its operation to the section, paragraph, clause, term, provision or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in such judgment shall be rendered.

Section 4: Short Title. This Ordinance may be cited as Ordinance No. 28-2015.
