

TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN

RESOLUTION NO. 79-2016

**AWARDING A CONTRACT TO CALGON CARBON CORPORATION
IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$376,400 FOR THE RENTAL OF
GRANULAR ACTIVATED CARBON FILTERS FOR USE AT THE
NORTH CHURCH STREET WATER TREATMENT PLANT**

WHEREAS, the Township of Moorestown requires a contract for goods and services for the rental of granular activated carbon filters at the North Church Street Water Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS, this carbon filter system is intended to serve as an immediate interim solution to address the concerns raised by the residents with regard to water quality; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(gg), the Township is authorized to enter into a contract with a vendor to acquire the filter system without public bidding; and

WHEREAS, consistent with public contracting laws, the Township Engineer received three quotes from qualified vendors and has, via correspondence dated February 22 2016, recommended a contract be awarded to Calgon Carbon for the rental and potential purchase of the equipment, and

WHEREAS, a Determination of Value Form, certifying that the costs associated with said services will exceed \$17,500, has been filed with the Township Clerk; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds for the proposed purchase; and

WHEREAS, an executed Business Entity Disclosure Certification, which certifies that the contractor has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the Township of Moorestown in the previous one year, and that the contract will prohibit the contractor from making any reportable contributions through the term of the contract, has been received by the Township Clerk; and

WHEREAS, an executed Political Contribution Disclosure Form was filed with the Municipal Clerk at least ten (10) days prior to award of the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Moorestown has met the provisions of the NJ Local Unit Pay-to-Play Law to award a contract under the Non-Fair and Open Contracts provisions of the Law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that:

1. Calgon Carbon Corporation, whose business address is 400 Calgon Carbon Drive, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania 15205, is hereby awarded a contract for the rental of granular activated carbon filters in an amount not to exceed \$376,400.00, which fee is based on an initial rental fee of \$170,000.00, a month to month rental fee of \$11,400.00 (not exceeding 12 months) and a demobilization fee of \$35,000.00.
2. Upon expiration of the rental term in the contract, the Township of Moorestown shall have the option to purchase the equipment for a cost of \$206,400.00.
3. Entry into a contract with the selected vendor is hereby approved, and the execution of an appropriate form of contract is hereby authorized.
4. A copy of the aforementioned contractual agreement shall be filed in the Office of the Township Clerk and made available for public inspection.
5. The Business Entity Disclosure Certification, Political Contribution Disclosure and Determination of Value Form be placed on file with this resolution.
6. The Township Clerk is hereby authorized to publish a "Notice of Award" of said contract in the official newspaper in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, within ten (10) days of its passage.
