RESOLUTION NO. 133-2016

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CHARGES FOR
POLICE SERVICES REQUESTED BY THIRD PARTIES**

WHEREAS, the Police Department from time-to-time provides services over and above regular service and duties, at the request of citizens, groups and other third parties; and

WHEREAS, to offset the administrative expenses incurred by such services, it is necessary for the Township to establish an appropriate fee schedule;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown as follows:

1. That the citizen, group or third party requesting such service shall be billed by the Township according to the following schedule to compensate the Township for the aforesaid costs:

From 1 July 2016 thru 31 December 2016	\$88.00 / hr.
From 1 January 2017	\$89.00 / hr.
From 1 January 2018	\$90.00 / hr.

2. In the event any person or group requesting such service has not paid a bill, which has been outstanding more than three (3) months for service of this type previously rendered, the Police Department shall automatically decline any additional requests for this type of service until all previous bills have been paid.
3. It is further understood the Township shall assess interest on all charges not paid within 30 days and take all necessary steps to collect said bill pursuant to law.
4. This resolution shall take effect upon execution of the contract by all parties.
