RESOLUTION 159-2016

**AUTHORIZING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$176,600 FOR THE ACQUISITION AND INSTALLATION OF A
TEMPORARY RADIONUCLIDES REMOVAL SYSTEM FOR THE NORTH CHURCH
STREET WATER TREATMENT PLANT**

WHEREAS, an emergency has arisen for the purpose of providing temporary treatment for the removal of radionuclides at the North Church Street Water Treatment Plant and no adequate provision was made in the 2016 Water & Sewer Utility Budget for this unforeseen purpose; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-46 provides for the creation of an emergency appropriation for such purpose, thereby increasing the overall Other Expenses budget appropriation by \$176,600 in excess of the 2016 Water & Sewer Utility Adopted Budget; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of emergency appropriations (including the appropriation to be created by this resolution) is \$176,600 and 3% of the total Current Fund and Utility Fund Budgets for the year 2016 is \$1,050,030.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey (not less than two-thirds of the full membership thereof affirmatively concurring) that, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:4-48;

1. Emergency appropriation is hereby made in the 2016 Water & Sewer Utility Adopted Budget for the purpose stated above in the aggregate amount of \$176,600.
2. That said emergency shall be provided in full in the 2017 budget.
3. That a certified copy of this resolution be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.
