ORDINANCE NO. 4-2016

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 168-76
OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN ENTITLED
“VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC – MID-BLOCK PEDESTRIAN CROSSWALKS”**

WHEREAS, the Moorestown Township Planning Board approved Resolution No. 2010-14 entitled, “A Resolution Granting Preliminary and Final Site Plan Approval Subject to Conditions, with Variance and Waiver Relief to Permit a Parking Lot in the RLC Residence Limited Commercial District with Parking in the Required Front Yard Set Back Area and Maintenance of a Modified Buffer in the Residence Limited Commercial Zoning District (RLC) Second Baptist Church, Block 4205, Lot 12” on November 4, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the approved site plan included the installation of a mid-block crosswalk linking the Second Baptist Church, 319 Mill Street, to the adjacent parking lot; and

WHEREAS, mid-block crosswalks are required to be codified in the Code of the Township of Moorestown; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, that:

Section 1: Chapter 168-76. “Schedule XXVI: Mid-Block Pedestrian Crosswalks” of the Code of the Township of Moorestown is hereby amended to add the following language:

NAME OF STREET LOCATION

Mill Street Beginning at a point 62 feet north of the northerly curb line of Beech Street to a point 6 feet north

Section 2: Regulatory signs shall be erected and maintained.

Section 3: In all other respects, Chapter 168 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4: Repealer. Any and all other ordinances inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 5: Severability. In the event that any section paragraph, clause, phrase, term, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, such judgment shall not effect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the section, paragraph, clause, phrase, term, provision or part thereof directly involved in the controversy if such judgment shall be rendered.

Section 6: Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon proper publication in accordance with law.

Section 7: Short Title. This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance 4-2016.
