RESOLUTION NO. 175-2016

APPROVING THE VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES (EMS) INCENTIVE REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, administrative members of Fire District No. 1, Fire District No. 2, Lenola Fire Company Emergency Unit and Moorestown First Aid and Emergency Squad have petitioned the Township Council to offer a volunteer incentive program to attract new volunteer members and retain existing members; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council desires to implement this initiative in order to support the Fire Districts' and EMS Squads' endeavors to attract new and maintain existing members for this vital public service; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council authorizes the Township Manager to create and oversee the policy and procedures necessary to put in place the volunteer incentive program that will permit qualifying volunteers to submit for reimbursement for certain township fees as established in the incentive policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown in Burlington County, State of New Jersey hereby approves the Volunteer Firefighter and EMS Incentive Reimbursement Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Township Council authorizes the Township Manager to administratively create and oversee the Incentive Program policy and procedures and is hereby approved to reimburse qualifying volunteers in accordance with the program.
