

TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN

ORDINANCE NO. 18-2016

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 168, SECTIONS 20 AND 66, OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC - PARKING PROHIBITED CERTAIN HOURS"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council, of the Township of Moorestown, in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that:

Section 1: Chapter 168-20. "Parking Prohibited Certain Hours" of the Code of the Township of Moorestown is hereby amended as follows:

- a. Language under Section 20 "Parking Prohibited Certain Hours" shall be added as follows:

168-20. Parking prohibited certain hours.
No person shall park a vehicle between the hours specified in Schedule XVI (§ 168-66) of any day, unless otherwise indicated, upon any of the streets or parts of streets or areas described in said Schedule XVI, attached to and made a part of this chapter.

Section 2: Chapter 168-66. Schedule XVI. "Parking Prohibited Certain Hours" of the Code of the Township of Moorestown is hereby amended as follows:

- a. The following language, under Schedule XVI: "Parking Prohibited Certain Hours" shall be added:

NAME OF STREET	SIDE	HOURS/DAYS	LOCATION
Main Street	Both	11:00 p.m.-6:00 a.m.	From Church Street to Chester Avenue
Chester Avenue	Both	11:00 p.m.-6:00 a.m.	From Main Street to Third Street
Municipal Parking Lot	All	11:00 p.m.-6:00 a.m.	Municipal Parking Lot (bound by North Church Street, North Washington Avenue, West Second Street and West Third Street)
West Parking Plaza	All	11:00 p.m.-6:00 a.m.	West Parking Plaza (bound by North Church Street, Mill Street, West Main Street and West Second Street)

- Section 2. Regulatory signs shall be erected and maintained to effectuate the above-designated “Parking Prohibited 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
- Section 3: In all other respects, Chapter 168 shall remain in full force and effect.
- Section 4: Repealer. Any and all other ordinances inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies
- Section 5: Severability. In the event that any section paragraph, clause phrase, term, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, such judgment shall not effect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the section, paragraph, clause, term, provision or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in such judgment shall be rendered.
- Section 6: Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon proper publication in accordance with law.
- Section 7: Short Title This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance 18-2016.
