RESOLUTION NO. 216-2016

APPROVING CONTRACT CHANGE ORDER NO. 1 EXCEEDING TWENTY PERCENT OF THE ORIGINAL CONTRACT PRICE FOR INSTALLATION OF A CARBON FILTER AND RADIUM REMOVAL SYSTEM AT THE NORTH CHURCH STREET WATER TREATMENT PLANT

WHEREAS, a contract was awarded to Eagle Construction Services, Inc. on August 8, 2016 in the amount of \$318,514 for the installation of a carbon filter and radium removal system at the North Church Street Water Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS, Change Order No. 1, in the amount of \$280,844, is necessary in order to complete the installation of three (3) additional filtration units which were not foreseen as necessary as part of the project at the time the project was bid and awarded; and

WHEREAS, the Township Engineer recommends Change Order No. 1 be approved for the subject project so that the filters can be properly installed; and

WHEREAS, this Change Order is necessary for the final completion of the installation of an overall carbon filter and radium removal system at the North Church Street Water Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS, this Change Order exceeds the original contract price by greater than twenty percent (20%) for a new contract amount not to exceed \$599,358; and

WHEREAS, all provisions of N.J.A.C.5:30-11.9 have been met with respect to the proper certifications being prepared and filed by the appropriate officials and annexed to this resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial officer has certified that the funds are available for said resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, that it does hereby approve Change Order No. 1 in excess of twenty percent (20%) of the original contract price for the subject project, which results in an increase in the overall contract for a new total contract amount not to exceed \$599,358.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that notification of this Change Order will be published in the Official Newspaper and a report of this Change Order will be made to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services on the appendix of the Township's Annual Budget.
