OBTAINING ACCREDITATION BY THE NEW JERSEY STATE
ASSOCIATION OF CHIEFS OF POLICE**

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.3 requires the Governing Body to pass a resolution authorizing the use of competitive contracting each time specialized goods or services are desired to be contracted; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Moorestown finds the competitive contracting process to be most advantageous to the Township and wishes to use the process for the purpose of retaining a consultant to provide a complete rewrite/revision of the Moorestown Township Police Department's standard operating procedures, policies and procedures, rules and regulations and any other related services required in the consultant assisting in obtaining accreditation by the New Jersey State Association of Chiefs of Police on behalf of the Moorestown Township Police Department.
