**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN, BURLINGTON COUNTY
REQUESTING THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, TRAFFIC ENGINEER, PERFORM
A TRAFFIC STUDY AND ANALYSIS ON NORTH CHURCH STREET (CR607) IN
MOORESTOWN BETWEEN MAIN STREET AND FLYNN AVENUE
FOR CONSIDERATION OF REDUCTION IN SPEED LIMIT**

WHEREAS, the Township of Moorestown has received many concerns from residents about the volume and speed in which traffic is travelling along North Church Street (CR607); and

WHEREAS, the safety of Moorestown residents and children crossing said CR607 for various school and recreational programs is of utmost concern; and

WHEREAS, CR607 serves as a major route for vehicles to travel from Route 38 to Route 130; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to reassess the speed limit along said CR607 due to safety concerns with the change in demographics over recent years and additional volume of tractor trailer traffic traveling through the narrowing road section of CR607 between Main Street and Flynn Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown that the Township does hereby request the County of Burlington, Traffic Engineer, conduct a traffic study and analysis of CR607 for the purpose of reducing the speed limit from Main Street to Flynn Avenue.
