RESOLUTION NO. 120-2017

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN, BURLINGTON COUNTY REQUESTING THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, TRAFFIC ENGINEER, PERFORM A TRAFFIC STUDY AND ANALYSIS ON WESTFIELD ROAD (CR614) IN MOORESTOWN BETWEEN BORTON LANDING ROAD AND BRIDGEBORO ROAD FOR CONSIDERATION OF REDUCTION IN SPEED LIMIT AND REQUESTING A PEDESTRIAN CROSSWALK BE INSTALLED TO PROVIDE SAFE PEDESTRIAN ACCESS BETWEEN THE SWEDES RUN DOG PARK AND THE ADJACENT WALKWAYS, BIKE PATH AND OPEN SPACE PARK

WHEREAS, the Township of Moorestown will be opening the Swedes Run Dog Park that is expected to attract a high volume of pedestrian traffic along Westfield Road (CR614); and

WHEREAS, since the Township's last request in November of 2010 by the Moorestown Police Traffic Safety Department, additional housing developments, retail shopping centers, and park attractions have increased the traffic volume; and

WHEREAS, the safety of Moorestown residents and children crossing said CR614 for various school and recreational programs is of utmost concern; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to reassess the speed limit along said CR614 due to the change in demographics over recent years with increased vehicle traffic to the Centerton Square shopping center, nursing home care facilities, dog park and ever expanding housing developments, to which CR614 is a main corridor; and

WHEREAS, to provide further safe access to the Swedes Run Dog Park and adjacent walkways, bike path and open space park, the Township of Moorestown further requests the County install a pedestrian crosswalk with appropriate signaling on CR614.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown that the Township does hereby request the County of Burlington, Traffic Engineer, conduct a traffic study and analysis of CR614 for the purpose of reducing the speed limit from Borton Landing Road to Bridgeboro Road.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown does hereby request the County to install a pedestrian crosswalk with appropriate signaling on CR614 to provide safe pedestrian access between the Swedes Run Dog Park and the adjacent walkways, bike path and open space park.
