RESOLUTION NO. 145-2017

**AUTHORIZING A SECOND AND FINAL ONE-YEAR EXTENSION OF A
CONTRACT TO SHANNON CHEMICAL CORPORATION
FOR PURCHASE AND DELIVERY OF
LIQUID CORROSION INHIBITOR/SEQUESTERING AGENT
FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$40,000**

WHEREAS, Shannon Chemical Corporation, with its principal place of business at PO Box 376, Malvern, Pennsylvania 19355, was awarded a Contract for the Purchase and Delivery of Liquid Corrosion Inhibitor/Sequestering Agent from June 1, 2015 through May 31, 2016; and

WHEREAS, said bid specifications and contract contained provisions, under the Terms of the Contract, that said contract was renewable for two additional years; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-15(43), states, in pertinent part, that any contract, with a term of three years or less, for services may include provisions for no more than one two-year, or two one-year extensions; and

WHEREAS, said contract was extended by the Township Council for a period of one year on April 25, 2016; and

WHEREAS, said contract expired on May 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Utilities Superintendent, via agenda report, has recommended a second and final one-year extension of said contract from June 1, 2017 until May 31, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body has found that the subject services are being performed in an effective and efficient manner; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Finance Officer has certified funds in the amount of \$40,000 (Appropriation No. 7-09-55-502-100-664).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that:

1. The contract between the Township of Moorestown and Shannon Chemical Corporation, dated May 5, 2015 is hereby extended for a second and final period of one year, from June 1, 2017 through May 31, 2018.
2. The same terms and conditions shall apply.
3. The amount of the contract shall remain the same.
