RESOLUTION NO. 141-2017

AWARDING A CONTRACT TO SOUTH STATE, INCORPORATED FOR THE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT ON NORTH CHURCH STREET, PROSPECT AVENUE, SOUTH WASHINGTON AVENUE, WEST SECOND STREET, MANNION AVENUE AND FAIRVIEW AVENUE IN AN AMOUNT OF \$1,502,303.00

WHEREAS, bids were received by the Township Clerk for the water main replacement on North Church Street, Prospect Avenue, South Washington Avenue, West Second Street, Mannion Avenue and Fairview Avenue on June 21, 2017; and

WHEREAS, three (3) bids were received as follows:

WHEREAS, the bid documents have been reviewed by L. Russell Trice, Township Engineer, who has recommended, via letter dated June 22, 2017, that the lowest responsible bidder be awarded the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Finance Officer has certified funds in the amount of \$1,502,303.00 (Appropriation No. W-08-55-565-020-902).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, that

1. A contract for the water main replacement on North Church Street, Prospect Avenue, South Washington Avenue, West Second Street, Mannion Avenue and Fairview Avenue is hereby awarded to the lowest responsible bidder, South State, Incorporated, PO Box 68, Bridgeton, New Jersey 08302 in the amount of \$1,502,303.00.
2. The Mayor and Township Clerk are hereby authorized to sign said contract and other documents necessary to implement this resolution.
