

TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN

ORDINANCE NO. 19-2017

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 168-72 ENTITLED “BUS STOPS”
OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council, of the Township of Moorestown, in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, that:

Section 1: Chapter 168-72. Schedule XXII: “Bus Stops” of the Code of the Township of Moorestown, is hereby amended as follows:

- a. The following language, under Schedule XXII: “Bus Stops” shall be inserted:

<u>NAME OF STREET</u>	<u>SIDE</u>	<u>LOCATION</u>
Camden Avenue (CR 537)	South	Garfield Avenue (far side) Beginning at the prolongation of the easterly curb line of Garfield Avenue and extending 100 feet easterly therefrom.

Section 3: Regulatory signs shall be erected and maintained to effectuate the above designated “Bus Stop” location.

Section 4: In all other respects, Chapter 168 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5: Repealer. Any and all other ordinances inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 6: Severability. In the event that any section, paragraph, clause, phrase, term, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction, to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, such judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the section, paragraph, clause, term, provision, or part thereof directly involved in the controversy, if such judgment is rendered.

Section 7: Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect, upon proper publication, in accordance with law.

Section 8: Short Title. This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance 19-2017.

The ordinance published herewith was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, held on October 23, 2017. This ordinance will be further considered for final passage by the Township Council at a meeting to be held in the Council Chamber of Town Hall, 111 West Second Street, Moorestown, New Jersey on November 13, 2017.
