

TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN

ORDINANCE NO. 14-2014

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6-45 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN ENTITLED "RECREATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE" BY INCREASING THE NUMBER OF ADDITIONAL STUDENT MEMBERS TO BE APPOINTED BY TWO

Whereas, the Recreation Advisory Committee realizes the importance of the participation of student members on the Recreation Advisory Committee (RAC); and

Whereas, the current ordinance provides that the (one or two) additional student members' appointments shall be for a period of one year and shall be students entering into their junior year of high school; and

Whereas, the RAC and Township Council realize the importance of effectuating continuity, as well as, diversity amongst the membership; and

Whereas, it is the goal of the RAC to increase the term of the student members and to encourage the student membership to be selected from a diverse pool of activity participation and experience, including, but not limited to, those participating in athletic sports programs, the arts and community service; and

Whereas, it has been recommended that the RAC be increased to add two additional student members entering into their sophomore year with all student members being selected from a diverse pool of activities.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 6-45 amended as follows:

Section 1: Section 45 shall be amended as follows:

Within the Department of Parks and Recreation, there shall be a Recreation Advisory Committee to consist of 11 members to be appointed by the Council, each for a term of two years. The Council ~~may~~ shall also appoint ~~one or two~~ four additional members, ~~each for a term of one year to run from July 1 to June 30 of each year.~~ The additional members' appointments shall be students entering into their junior year of high school as follows:

1. Upon adoption of this ordinance, two students, one male and one female, entering into their sophomore year shall be appointed to a two-year term.
2. Upon adoption of this ordinance, two students, one male and one female, entering into their junior year, shall be appointed to a one-year term (if they have not yet been appointed).

3. Each year thereafter, two students, one male and one female, entering into their sophomore year, shall be appointed to a two-year term.
4. All student member terms shall run from July 1 to June 30.
5. All student members are required to comply with the meeting attendance policy for boards and committees as adopted by the Township Council annually.
6. All student members shall be entitled to receive community service hours for hours served.

The Committee shall provide for its own organization and shall consult with and advise the Council, Manager and Director from time to time with respect to recreational policies, programs and activities within the Township. No person may serve more than four successive full terms.

Section 6: In all other respects, Chapter 6 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 7: Repealer. Any and all other ordinances inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies

Section 8: Severability. In the event that any section paragraph, clause phrase, term, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, such judgment shall not effect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the section, paragraph, clause, term, provision or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in such judgment shall be rendered.

Section 9: Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon proper publication and in accordance with law.

Section 10: Short Title. This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance 14-2014.

NOTICE

The ordinance published herewith was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, held on September 22, 2014.
