

**TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN**

**ORDINANCE NO. 3-2012**

**MAKING VARIOUS AMENDMENTS TO CHAPTER 168 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN ENTITLED “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC”**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council, of the Township of Moorestown, in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, that:

Section 1: Chapter 168-52, Schedule II: “Speed Limits” of the Code of the Township of Moorestown, is hereby amended as follows:

<u>NAME OF STREET</u>	<u>SPEED LIMIT</u>	<u>ZONE</u>	<u>LOCATION</u>
New Albany Road	35	--	<del>From Camden Avenue to Riverton Road (delete)</del> Entire Length (insert)

Section 2: Chapter 168-65. Schedule XV: “No Stopping or Standing” of the Code of the Township of Moorestown, is hereby amended to add the following language:

<u>NAME OF STREET</u>	<u>SIDE</u>	<u>LOCATION</u>
Kings Highway	North	From a point 80 feet east of Pleasant Valley Avenue to a point 120 feet west
	South	From a point 100 feet west of Pleasant Valley Avenue to a point 120 feet east
Pleasant Valley Avenue	East	From a point 80 feet south of Kings Highway (CR 611) to a point 90 feet north
	West	From Kings Highway to a point 105 feet north

Section 3: Regulatory signs shall be erected and maintained to effectuate the above designated Speed Limits and “No Stopping or Standing” locations as authorized by the New Jersey Department of Transportation.

Section 4: In all other respects, Chapter 168 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5: Repealer. Any and all other ordinances inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 6:     Severability.    In the event that any section, paragraph, clause, phrase, term, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction, to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, such judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the section, paragraph, clause, phrase, term, provision, or part thereof directly involved in the controversy, if such judgment is rendered.

Section 7:     Effective Date.   This ordinance shall take effect, upon proper publication, in accordance with law.

Section 8:     Short Title.   This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance 3-2012.
