

TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN

ORDINANCE NO. 27-2011

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN AMENDING CHAPTER 208, "SEWAGE DISPOSAL" OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN

WHEREAS, the Township of Moorestown previously adopted an Ordinance concerning Sewage Disposal systems in the Township; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid ordinance does not include all of the pertinent information the Moorestown Environmental Advisory Committee and the Planning Board deem necessary to properly evaluate an application; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Moorestown has determined that it is in the best interests of the Township to modify the present sewage disposal ordinance to include all of the information that is required to make an informed decision.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, that Section 208-5, of the Moorestown Code, is hereby amended to include the following items:

Section 1: Section 208-5 shall be amended by adding the following paragraphs:

- F. The slopes on mounded systems are to be a minimum of 5:1.
- G. Pressure dosing systems shall have a minimum size of 1.61 square feet of bottom area per gallon of daily sewage volume.
- H. Septic systems shall be designed/sized to accommodate garbage disposals, even if installation is not immediately planned.
- I. If, during construction of a septic field, tile drains are encountered, the tile drains are to be removed to the property line or to 100 feet from the outside of the septic field, whichever limit is encountered first.

Section 2: In all other respects, Chapters 208 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3: Repealer. Any and all other ordinances inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 4: Severability. In the event that any section paragraph, clause phrase, term, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, such judgment shall not effect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the section, paragraph, clause, term, provision or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in such judgment shall be rendered.

Section 5: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first publication thereof, after final passage and in accordance with law.

Section 6: Short Title. This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance 27-2011.
