

**TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN**

**ORDINANCE NO. 25-2009**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 46-7  
OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN ENTITLED  
“ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES - VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES”**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, Burlington County, State of New Jersey, that:

Section 1. Chapter 46-7, “Violations and penalties” of the Code of the Township of Moorestown, is hereby amended as follows:

A. Paragraph 46-7, “Violations and penalties,” shall be deleted in its entirety and the following language inserted in its place:

**§ 46-7. Violations and penalties, [Amended 7-28-1997 by Ord. No. 1830-97]**

Any person who violates this article, shall, upon conviction thereof, in a proceeding before a court of competent jurisdiction, be subject to a fine not less than \$100 and shall be required to perform a period of community service not to exceed five (5) days.

For a second offense, persons shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$300 and a period of community service not to exceed ten (10) days.

For a third and subsequent offense, persons shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$500 and a period of community service not to exceed thirty (30) days.

Section 2. In all other respects, Chapter 46 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. Repealer. Any and all other ordinances inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions, or part of this ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 4. Severability. In the event that any section, paragraph, clause, phrase, term, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction, to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, such judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation, to the section, paragraph, clause, term, provision, or part thereof directly involved in the controversy, if such judgment shall be rendered.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect, upon proper publication, in accordance with the law.

Section 6. Short Title. This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance 25-2009.

#### NOTICE

The ordinance published herewith was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, held on September 14, 2009.
