ORDINANCE NO. 14-2005

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 168 OF THE CODE OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN ENTITLED “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC”
TO ESTABLISH DESIGNATED “BICYCLE LANES”**

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown desires to designate Bicycle Lanes as defined in and in accordance with the “Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways” along Haines Drive in the Township of Moorestown; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council finds that it is in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare to establish Bicycle Lanes subject to the review and approval of the New Jersey Department of Transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council, of the Township of Moorestown, in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, that:

Section 1: Chapter 168 shall be amended to add the following section:

**ARTICLE X
Bicycle Lanes**

168-88. Definitions.

BICYCLE LANE – A Bicycle Lane is the portion of a roadway that has been designated by signs and pavement markings for preferential or exclusive use by bicyclists. A Bicycle Lane shall be differentiated from a bicycle path in that a “lane” is part of the roadway and is shared with vehicular traffic. In addition, all Bicycle Lanes shall conform to the current edition of the “Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways.”

168-89. Driving, Parking, Standing and Stopping.

It shall be unlawful for any person to drive, park, stop or stand any motor vehicle in any location designated in this chapter as a Bicycle Lane. The locations described in Schedule XXVII (Section 168.76.1) attached hereto and made a part of this chapter, are hereby designated as Bicycle Lanes.

168.90. Violations and Penalties.

Occurrences in a bicycle lane, upon any roadway in the Township of Moorestown, are subject to the “Violations and Penalties” provisions of Chapter 168-3 of the Code of the Township of Moorestown and Title 39 of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated.

Section 2: Chapter 168, Article VIII "Schedule" shall be amended to include the following section:

168.76.1. Schedule XXVII: Bicycle Lanes.

The lane locations described are hereby designated as Bicycle Lanes. Bicycle Lanes shall conform to the current edition of the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways."

Section 3: Signage and pavement markings shall be constructed and maintained in accordance with the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways."

Section 4: In all other respects, Chapter 168 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5: Repealer. Any and all other ordinances inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 6: Severability. In the event that any section or paragraph, clause, phrase, term, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, such judgment shall not effect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the section, paragraph, clause, term, provision, or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in such judgment, shall be rendered.

Section 7: Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon proper publication and in accordance with law.

Section 8: Short Title. This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance 14-2005.

NOTICE

The ordinance published herewith was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, held on April 18, 2005. This ordinance will be further considered for final passage by the Township Council at a meeting to be held in the Council Chambers of Moorestown Township, 111 West Second Street, Moorestown, NJ on May 9, 2005 at 8pm or at any time and place to which such meeting may be adjourned.
