

TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN

ORDINANCE NO. 40-2005

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 168 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN ENTITLED “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC” TO ESTABLISH “MULTI-WAY STOP INTERSECTIONS”

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown finds it in the interest of public safety to designate West Second Street and Locust Street as a Multi-Way Stop Intersection subject to the review and approval of the New Jersey Department of Transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, in the County of Burlington and in the State of New Jersey, that West Second Street and Locust Street shall be designated as a Multi-Way Stop Intersection

Section 1: Chapter 168-11 entitled Stop Intersections shall be amended to read as follows:

The intersections described in Schedule VIII (168-58 and 168-58.1), attached to and made a part of this chapter, are hereby designated as stop intersections. Stop signs shall be installed as provided herein.

Section 2: Chapter 168, Acticle VIII shall be amended to add the following language under “Schedule VIII: Stop Intersections”

168-58.1 Schedule VIII: Multi-way Stop Intersections

Pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39: 4-140 and 168-11 of the Code of the Township, the intersections described herein are hereby designated as Multi-Way Stop Intersections and stop signs shall be installed as follows:

Intersection	Stop Sign On:
West Second Street and Locust Street	All approaches

Section 3: Signage and pavement markings shall be constructed and maintained in accordance with the “Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways.”

Section 4. Violations and Penalties. Violations and Penalties are established in Section 168-3 of the Code of the Township of Moorestown.

Section 5: In all other respects, Chapter 168 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6: Repealer. Any and all other ordinances inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 7: Severability. In the event that any section or paragraph, clause, phrase, term, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, such judgement shall not effect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the section, paragraph, clause, term, provision, or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in such judgement, shall be rendered.

Section 8: Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon proper publication in accordance with law and upon approval by the New Jersey Department of Transportation.

Section 9: Short Title. This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance 40-2005.
