

TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN**ORDINANCE NO. 10-2004****AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 175
OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN ENTITLED
“WATER AND SEWERS” TO REVISE CERTAIN WATER RATES**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council, of the Township of Moorestown, in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that:

Section 1: Paragraph 175-21A(4), *Water rates for schools and nonprofits*, is hereby amended by deleting the rate of \$2.44 per 1,000 gallons for all water in excess of 30,000 gallons through 300,000 gallons per quarter; and \$3.57 per 1,000 gallons for all water in excess of 300,000 gallons. For all water furnished through a meter installed solely for the purposes of irrigation, billings shall be based on the gallons furnished at \$3.01 per 1,000 gallons for the first 100,000 gallons per quarter and \$4.26 per 1,000 gallons for all water in excess of 100,000 gallons per quarter”; and replacing it with the following rate of: \$2.57 per 1,000 gallons for all water in excess of 30,000 gallons through 300,000 gallons per quarter; and \$3.96 per 1,000 gallons for all water in excess of 300,000 gallons per quarter. For all water furnished through a meter installed solely for the purposes of irrigation, billings shall be based on the gallons furnished at \$3.18 per 1,000 gallons for the first 100,000 gallons per quarter and \$4.73 per 1,000 gallons for all water in excess of 100,000 gallons per quarter.”

Section 2: Paragraphs 175-21A(5), *Property used for commercial and/or industrial use*, is hereby amended by deleting the rate of “\$3.01 per 1,000 gallons for all water in excess of 30,000 gallons per quarter through 100,000 gallons per quarter; and \$4.47 per 1,000 gallons for all water in excess of 100,000 gallons per quarter. For all water furnished through a meter installed solely for the purposes of irrigation, billings shall be based on the gallons furnished at \$3.01 per 1,000 gallons for the first 100,000 gallons per quarter and \$4.47 per 1,000 gallons for all water in excess of 100,000 gallons per quarter”; and replacing it with the rate of “\$3.18 per 1,000 gallons for all water in excess of 30,000 gallons per quarter through 100,000 gallons per quarter; and \$4.96 per 1,000 gallons for all water in excess of 100,000 gallons per quarter. For all water furnished through a meter installed solely for the purposes of irrigation, billings shall be based on the gallons furnished at \$3.18 per 1,000 gallons for the first 100,000 gallons per quarter and \$4.96 per 1,000 gallons for all water in excess of 100,000 gallons per quarter.”

Section 3: Paragraphs 175-21A(8), *Water rates for all other customers*, is hereby amended to delete the rate of “\$3.01 per 1,000 gallons for all water in excess of 30,000 gallons per quarter through 100,000 gallons per quarter; and \$4.47 per 1,000 gallons for all water in excess of 100,000 gallons. All water furnished through a meter installed solely for the purposes of irrigation, billings shall be based on the gallons furnished at \$3.01 per 1,000 gallons for the first 100,000 gallons per quarter and \$4.47 per 1,000 gallons for all water in excess of 100,000 gallons per quarter”; and replacing it with the rate of “\$3.18 per 1,000 gallons for all water in excess of 30,000 gallons per quarter through 100,000 gallons per quarter; and \$4.96 per 1,000 gallons for all

water in excess of 100,000 gallons per quarter. All water furnished through a meter installed solely for the purposes of irrigation, billings shall be based on the gallons furnished at \$3.18 per 1,000 gallons for the first 100,000 gallons per quarter and \$4.96 per 1,000 gallons for all water in excess of 100,000 gallons per quarter.”

Section 4: Paragraph 175-21B, *Effective date of water rates*, is hereby amended by deleting each reference to “May 1, 2003” and replacing it with “May 1, 2004.”

Section 5. In all other respects, Chapter 175 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. Repealer. Any and all other ordinances inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies

Section 7. Severability. In the event that any section paragraph, clause phrase, term, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, such judgment shall not effect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the section, paragraph, clause, term, provision or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in such judgment shall be rendered.

Section 8. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon proper publication in accordance with law.

Section 9. Short Title. This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance 10-2004.
