

TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN

ORDINANCE NO. 13-2006

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 11 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN ENTITLED DRUG-FREE SCHOOL ZONES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council, of the Township of Moorestown, in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that:

Section 1: Chapter 11, Section 1. "Approval and Adoption of Map" is hereby amended to add the following language:

§ 11-1. Approval and adoption of map.

In accordance with and pursuant to the authority of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-1 et seq. (L. 1987, c. 101 and c. 106) and L. 1988, c. 44 (N.J.S.A. 2C:35-7), collectively referred to as the "Comprehensive Drug Reform Act of 1987," as amended and supplemented (the "Act"), the Drug-Free School Zone Map produced on or about November 16, 1987, amended by map dated April 5, 2006, by Remington & Vernick, Township Engineers, is hereby approved and adopted as a formal governmental or official finding and record of the locations and boundaries of areas within the Township of property used for school purposes and owned by or leased to an elementary or secondary school or school board (hereinafter, "school property") and of the boundaries of all areas within 1,000 feet of such school property (hereinafter, "one-thousand-foot areas"). The school property and the one-thousand-foot areas shall, together, constitute and be known as "Drug-Free School Zones."

Section 2. Chapter 11, Section 5B is hereby amended to as follows:

§ 11-5. Purpose, intent and declaration.

B. All of the property depicted on the map approved and adopted herein as school property was owned by or leased to a school or school board and was being used for school purposes ~~as of~~ on or after July 9, 1987, the effective date of the pertinent provisions of the Act.

Section 3: In all other respects, Chapter 11 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4: Repealer. Any and all other ordinances inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies

Section 5: Severability. In the event that any section paragraph, clause phrase, term, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, such judgment shall not effect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the section, paragraph, clause, term, provision or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in such judgment shall be rendered.

Section 6: Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon proper publication in accordance with law.

Section 7: Short Title. This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance 13-2006.
