ORDINANCE NO. 14-2006

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN
TO AMEND CHAPTER 125 ENTITLED "PARKS AND RECREATION FACILITIES"
OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN
TO REVISE AND SUPPLEMENT SCHEDULE A
(DESCRIPTION AND LOCATION OF FACILITIES)**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council, of the Township of Moorestown, in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that:

WHEREAS, SCHEDULE A contained in Chapter 125 identifies the location of parks and recreational facilities in the Township of Moorestown; and

WHEREAS, SCHEDULE A is in need of revisions, and other supplements due to additional park and recreational facilities having been acquired by the Township of Moorestown since SCHEDULE A was last amended.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. The following paragraphs, contained in SCHEDULE A, shall be revised as follows:

- F. Pompeston Creek Park - Block 3500, Lot 44 shall be added and Block 4100, Lots 23 and 24 shall be changed to Block 4101, Lots 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 84, 88 and 89.
- H. Beech Street Park - Block 4307, Lot 9 shall be changed to Block 4307, Lots 9, 10, 11 and 12.
- I. Grounds of Perkins Center for the Arts - Block 2001, Lots 8 and 9 shall be changed to Block 2001, Lots 7, 8 and 9.
- J. Strawbridge Lake Park - Block 2900, Lot 15 shall be changed to Block 2900, Lots 1 and 15 and Block 3301, Lot 39 shall be changed to Block 3301, Lots 39 and 53.
- L. Wesley Bishop Park - Block 502, Lots 44 and 5 shall be changed to Block 502, Lot 5.
- N. Salem Road Park—Block 7200, Lot 4.01 shall be changed to Block 7201, Lot 4.01.

Section 2. SCHEDULE A shall be supplemented by adding the following paragraphs:

- O. Locust Street Park, located on Locust Street and Kenilworth Avenue, and also known as “Block 2103, Lot 22 and Block 2400, Lot 1,” as shown on the Tax Map of the Township.
- P. Remembrance Park, located on Camden Avenue and West Second Street, and also known as “Block 2109, Lot 1,” as shown on the Tax Map of the Township.
- Q. Wigmore Acres, located on Westfield and Bridgeboro Roads, and also known as “Block 7000, Lot 1,” as shown on the Tax Map of the Township.
- R. Little Woods, located on Creek Road, and also known as “Block 8600, Lot 8,” as shown on the Tax Map of the Township.
- S. Esther Yanai Preserve located on Garwood Road, and also known as “Block 7100, Lot 11,” as shown on the Tax Map of the Township.

Section 3: In all other respects, Chapter 125 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4: Repealer. Any and all other ordinances inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 5: Severability. In the event that any section paragraph, clause phrase, term, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, such judgment shall not effect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the section, paragraph, clause, term, provision or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in such judgment shall be rendered.

Section 6: Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon proper publication in accordance with law.

Section 7: Short Title. This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance 14-2006.

NOTICE
