

TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN

ORDINANCE NO. 29-2006

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 734 “THE MOORESTOWN TOWNSHIP SALARIES AND COMPENSATION ORDINANCE OF 1973,” AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED, BY PROVIDING FOR SALARY ADJUSTMENTS FOR SUPERVISORY AND TECHNICAL EMPLOYEES AND CERTAIN PART-TIME EMPLOYEES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of The Township of Moorestown in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, that:

SECTION 1: The “Moorestown Salaries and Compensation Ordinance of 1973,” (Ordinance No. 734) as amended and supplemented, is hereby amended as follows:

- A. Section 1(a) is hereby amended to read as follows:
Section 1(a) the following employees of said Township shall receive as an annual salary or compensation the amount indicated in the schedule set forth below:

SECTION 2: Section 1A shall have effect insofar as necessary retroactively, effective December 23, 2005 and shall apply to work and services performed on and since December 23, 2005.

The Housing Committee Secretary, Planning Board Secretary and Zoning Board Secretary shall have effect insofar as necessary retroactively, effective July 7, 2006.

School Traffic Guards shall have effect insofar as necessary retroactively, effective September 7, 2006.

Recreation Aide shall be effective October 1, 2006 in accordance with Resolution 172-2006.

SECTION 3: In all other respects, said Ordinance No. 734, as amended and supplemented shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4: All other ordinances and parts of ordinances and resolutions, insofar as they are inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency only.

SECTION 5: If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, term, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or inoperative, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof phrase, term, provision or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

SECTION 6: This ordinance may be cited as ordinance 29-2006.

NOTICE AND CERTIFICATION

The ordinance published herewith was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, held on November 13, 2006. This ordinance will be further considered for final passage by the Township Council at a meeting to be held in the Council Chambers of Moorestown Township, 111 West Second Street, Moorestown, NJ on November 27, 2006 at 8pm or at any time and place to which such meeting may be adjourned. All persons interested will be given the opportunity to be heard concerning such ordinance. During the week prior to and including the date of such further consideration, copies will be made available at the Municipal Clerk's Office in said Municipal Building to any member of the general public who shall request such copies.
