RESOLUTION NO. 21-2013

**APPOINTING T & M ASSOCIATES AS ALTERNATE ENGINEER
AND AUTHORIZING AWARD OF THE CONTRACT FOR 2013**

WHEREAS, the Township of Moorestown requires the services of an Alternate Professional Engineer for various engineering projects; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Moorestown (“Township”) sought Requests for Proposals, in accordance with the “fair and open” provisions of the New Jersey Pay-to-Play Laws, for the services of a Township Attorney; and

WHEREAS, three (3) proposals were received and publicly opened on January 3, 2013; and

WHEREAS, said submissions have been reviewed and ranked; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council has found that T & M Associates satisfactorily meets all the criteria set forth in the Request for Proposals and recommends that T & M Associates be awarded a professional services contract for the year 2013.

WHEREAS, a Determination of Value Form, certifying that the costs associated with said services will exceed \$17,500, has been filed with the Township Clerk; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that:

1. T & M Associates, 1256 North Church Street, Moorestown, New Jersey 08057, is hereby appointed to provide Township Engineering Services as requested for the year 2013 pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44a-20.5 (fair and open) and Chapter 10 of the Code of the Township of Moorestown. Said appointment shall expire upon the Reorganization Meeting of the Township Council in 2014.
2. A contractual agreement summarizing the services to be performed by the Alternate Engineer and the fees (\$132 per hour/engineer) to be charged for same, are hereby approved and execution of the contract is authorized.
3. A copy of the aforementioned contractual agreement shall be filed in the Office of the Township Clerk and made available for public inspection.
