**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TRANSFERS  
OF 2012 BUDGET APPROPRIATION RESERVES**

WHEREAS, there exist certain 2012 budget appropriation reserves which have insufficient balances to meet their obligation; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A.40A:4-59 permits, that during the first three months of the fiscal year, the amount of any appropriation reserve for the immediately preceding year which has a balance insufficient to meet its obligation, to make transfers of sums from appropriation reserves with amounts in excess of those necessary to fulfill the purpose of those appropriation reserves to appropriation reserves which may be insufficient;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, in Burlington County, State of New Jersey, that the following 2012 budget appropriation reserve transfers are hereby authorized:
