RESOLUTION NO. 89-2013

APPOINTING FIRST ALTERNATE TOWNSHIP PROSECUTOR FOR 2013

WHEREAS, pursuant to Moorestown Township Resolution 14-2013, the Township of Moorestown has appointed a Township Prosecutor for the year 2013; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 2B:25-4 (e) provides for the appointment of Alternate Township Prosecutors, each of whom shall, when the Township Prosecutor is unavailable and has designated him or her, act in the capacity of Township Prosecutor and represent the State, County and the Township in any matter within the jurisdiction of the Municipal Court, and counsel Moorestown's Department of Police with respect to matters pending or anticipated before the Municipal Court; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown has determined that it is in the best interest of the Township to appoint Alternate Township Prosecutors to serve in the absence of the Township Prosecutor.

WHEREAS, via Resolution 15-2013, a First Alternate Prosecutor, Kimberly Garrigues, was appointed; however, due to a conflict, there exists a vacancy and Township Council wishes to appoint George Morris, Esquire, Parker McCay, 9000 Midlantic Drive, Mount Laurel, New Jersey 08054 to fill the vacancy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, that the following individual is hereby appointed as First Alternate Township Prosecutor for the Township of Moorestown, whom shall, when the Township Prosecutor is unavailable and has designated him or her, act in the capacity of Township Prosecutor and represent the State, County and the Township in any matter within the jurisdiction of the Municipal Court, and counsel Moorestown's Department of Police with respect to matters pending or anticipated before the Municipal Court.
