RESOLUTION NO. 106-2013

APPROVING FEE PROPOSAL FROM RAGAN DESIGN GROUP IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,000 IN CONNECTION WITH THE TOWN HALL/LIBRARY PROJECT FOR EVALUATION OF THE POLICE AND COURT NEEDS AND POTENTIAL REPURPOSING OF THE LIBRARY BUILDING

WHEREAS, Resolution 64-2011 authorized a professional services contract with Ragan Design Group (the "Architect") for the Town Hall/Library Project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, said contract states, *Architect shall submit a proposal, which sets forth the scope of work, for each phase of the Project. Each phase and related proposal shall be approved by Council. Each approved proposal shall be made part of the contract,*" and

WHEREAS, the Township Council is considering how best to address the needs of the Police and Court along with the potential repurposing of the Library building, within the context of redevelopment of the municipal complex and it wishes to review its options concerning repair, renovation, addition and/or demolition; and

WHEREAS, the Architect has submitted a proposal dated May 1, 2013 in the amount of \$25,000.00 to provide a Police/Court Study and a Building Repurposing Report in connection with the existing Library Building, located at 111 West Second Street (the "Proposal"); and

WHEREAS, the Chief Finance Officer has filed the required Certification of Funds with the Township Clerk; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, that the Architect's Proposal is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Township Manager is hereby authorized to sign the Proposal, which shall be made part of the contract.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of the contract be filed in the Office of the Township Clerk and made available for public inspection.
