

**TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN**

**RESOLUTION NO. 120-2013**

**ADOPTING THE MOORESTOWN BICYCLE CIRCULATION AND SAFETY PLAN**

WHEREAS, the Moorestown Township Council in cooperation with its member entities and the Moorestown Bicycle Safety Committee, developed a Moorestown Bicycle Circulation and Safety Plan (the “Plan”) to: 1) serve as a basis from which additional planning, actions and safety recommendations would be explored and implemented, 2) that identifies and recommends improvements, signage and, 3) establishes corridors to preserve for the creation of a regional and local walking and biking network; and

WHEREAS, the intention of the Moorestown Bicycle Safety Committee is to research and provide more mode choice to residents and visitors and to encourage walking and biking as a safe and viable option for commuting and recreating; and

WHEREAS, the Plan outlines policies and recommended standards to guide bicycle and pedestrian planning, via county and township roadways; and

WHEREAS, the Plan recommends implementation strategies for the expansion of existing walking and biking networks; and

WHEREAS, opportunities for public involvement were provided throughout the process, at the library and township website; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown approved the creation of the Moorestown Bicycle Circulation and Safety Plan at its meeting on July 27, 2009.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, does adopt the Moorestown Bicycle Circulation and Safety Plan.
