**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TRANSFERS
OF 2013 BUDGET APPROPRIATION RESERVES**

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A.40A:4-59 permits, that during the first three months of the fiscal year, the amount of any appropriation reserve for the immediately preceding year which has a balance insufficient to meet its obligation, to make transfers of sums from appropriations with amounts in excess of those necessary to fulfill the purpose of those appropriations to appropriations which may be insufficient;
