ORDINANCE NO. 3-2016

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN AMENDING
CHAPTER 101 ENTITLED “LICENSING,” SECTION 13 “DEALERS
RESPONSIBILITIES, REQUIREMENTS AND RECORDKEEPING”**

WHEREAS, the Acting Police Chief has recommended that Section 13D of Chapter 101 be amended in order that it be in accord with State statute, N.J.S.A. 2C:36-21(d).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington, that Chapter 101, Section 13 of the Code of the Township of Moorestown be amended as follows:

Section 1. Section 13D, first sentence, shall be amended by deleting the word “three” and replacing it with the word “ten” as follows:

- D. All of the above-described property cannot be sold or disposed of and shall be made available for inspection by any sworn police officer in the performance of his or her duties for a period of ~~three~~ **ten** business days from the date the information required above is received by the Director of Police in the prescribed electronic format.

Section 4. **Repealer.** Any and all other ordinances inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 5. **Severability.** In the event that any section paragraph, clause phrase, term, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, such judgment shall not effect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the section, paragraph, clause, term, provision or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in such judgment shall be rendered.

Section 6. **Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect 20 days after publication of Notice of Final Passage.

Section 7. **Short Title.** This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance 3-2016.
