# AN IMPORTANT ADVISORY FROM THE POLICE DEPARTMENT “ATTENTION RESIDENTS AND BUSINESS OWNERS”

Please be advised that, with the adoption of Ordinance 5-2006 on March 20, 2006, the penalty for a false alarm will be increased. Following the third false alarm in any calendar year, the Director of Police will cause a notice to be mailed to the property owner. A subsequent false alarm in the calendar year will result in the imposition of a fine in accordance with the following schedule:

4th false alarm	\$ 50
5th false alarm	\$100
6th false alarm	\$150
7th false alarm	\$200
8th false alarm	\$250
9th false alarm	
10th false alarm	
11th false alarm	
12th false alarm	
Each subsequent false alarm

# OLD FASHION 4TH OF JULY PARADE

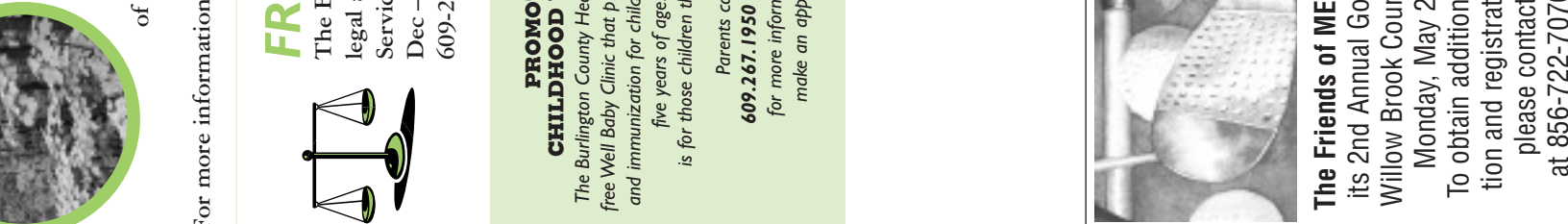

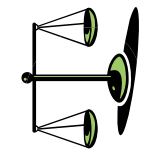

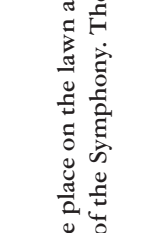


**PROMOTING CHILDHOOD WELLNESS**

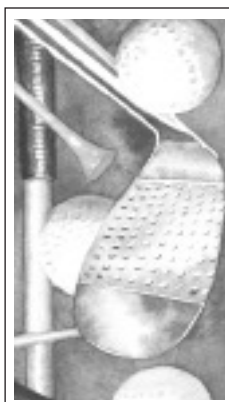

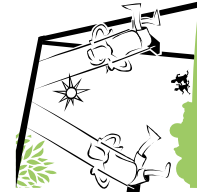
