**A RESOLUTION SETTING THE ANNUAL MEETING SCHEDULE OF THE
HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
MOORESTOWN FOR 2025**

BE IT RESOLVED by the Historic Preservation Commission of The Township of Moorestown, in the County of Burlington, in the State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. Regular meetings of the Moorestown Township Historic Preservation Commission will be held during 2025 at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers, Town Hall, 111 West Second St., Moorestown, New Jersey 08057, according to the attached Annual Schedule of Meetings, unless otherwise noted.
2. The Historic Preservation Commission also establishes the date, time and place for its **first meeting of 2026, as January 22, 2026** at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers, Town Hall, 111 West Second St., Moorestown, New Jersey 08057. This will be the reorganization meeting and will establish the "Annual Notice," and the selection of the slate of officers.
3. The approval of minutes and memorialization of resolutions may take place at any meeting.
4. The Historic Preservation Commission Chairperson may at any time appoint members to committees and designate the Chairperson of each committee.
5. The Historic Preservation Commission Chairperson may at his/her discretion assign or delegate other functions and responsibilities to individual members of subcommittees of the Historic Preservation Commission. Any such assignment or delegation shall be reported by the Chairperson to the Historic Preservation Commission at its next regular meeting following the assignment or delegation.
6. Special meetings of the Historic Preservation Commission may be called by:
 - a. The Chairperson;
 - b. The Vice-Chairperson;
 - c. Three (3) or more members of the Historic Preservation Commission.
7. Notice or call of a special meeting shall be delivered to the Historic Preservation Commission members, the Office of the Township Clerk, the official newspapers of the Historic Preservation Commission, and posted in the lobby of Town Hall, at least 48 hours prior to the time of the special meeting.
8. The Burlington County Times is the official Township of Moorestown newspaper

and the Courier Post as the alternate official Township of Moorestown newspaper, are hereby designated as the newspapers to receive notices required by the State of New Jersey Open Public Meetings Act, Chapter 231, P.L., 1975.

A motion duly made by Mr. Chepurny and duly seconded by Ms. Bunn that the above resolution be adopted. The above resolution was ADOPTED by a 5 to 0 vote of the Township of Moorestown Historic Preservation Commission at a meeting held on May 15, 2025.
