RESOLUTION NO. 38-2026

DESIGNATING AN AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT COORDINATOR  
AND ADOPTING GRIEVANCE PROCEDURES  
PURSUANT TO THE CODE OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS  
TITLE 28, CHAPTER 1, PART 35 SUBPART A, SECTION 35.107

WHEREAS, Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, as amended by the ADA Amendments Act of 2008 (collectively, the "ADA"), prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability by public entities; and

WHEREAS, the regulations implementing the ADA are set forth in the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 28 Judicial Administration, Chapter 1, Part 35 (the "ADA Regulations"), and require that a public entity that employs 50 or more persons shall designate at least one employee to coordinate its efforts to comply with and carry out its responsibilities under the ADA and the ADA Regulations; and

WHEREAS, the ADA Regulations also require that a public entity that employs 50 or more persons shall adopt and publish grievance procedures providing for prompt and equitable resolution of complaints alleging any action that would be prohibited under the ADA or the ADA Regulations.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that the Township Manager, or the Manager's designee, is hereby designated as the Township's Americans with Disabilities Act Coordinator.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Township Council hereby adopts the attached grievance procedures and directs that the Americans with Disabilities Act Coordinator cause same to be published and made available to the public upon request.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the grievance procedures be reviewed, updated as needed and adopted annually by the Township Council.
